REGULAR MEETING

The Regular Meeting of the Hempfield Township Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday evening, July 2, 2024, at 7:00 P.M. in the Township Municipal Building.

All of the Supervisors were present.

Chairman Gary Hittle called the Regular Meeting to order.

Chairman Hittle opened the meeting for Public Comment. There was none.

Chairman Hittle said he would entertain a motion to dispense with the reading and approve of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 4, 2024. Supervisor Geisel made the motion, Supervisor Todd Hittle duly seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved by Chairman Hittle. Motion carried. Chairman Hittle said the minutes are a public document and may be viewed at any time during regular business hours.

Chairman Hittle said that there are activities for the Hempfield Township Volunteer Fire Department which must be approved by the Supervisors at this time. They are: July 6-Heritage Day Car Show Raffle; July 8-Directors/Membership Meeting; July 11- Training; July 19- Golf Outing Prep; July 20- Golf Outing; July 25- Training; July 27- DQ Fundraiser. Vice-Chairman Geisel made a motion to approve the activities mentioned. It was duly seconded by Supervisor Hittle and unanimously approved by Chairman Hittle. Motion carried.

Next on the Agenda is the viewing of reports of the various Township departments. The police report for the month of June was first presented. The men worked 741-man hours and traveled 4,554 miles. They issued no traffic citations. There were 6 accidents with 3 injuries. There were 43 criminal-related incidents, 347 service incidents, 29 police information, and 63 additional traffic related incidents. Property stolen was in the amount of \$106.56 with \$106.56 recovered. No property was damaged.

There were 2 zoning permits issued by the Zoning Administrator for the month of June. They were issued as follows: The Toth Family Farms for a seasonal agricultural stand on Hadley Road and Brian Peterson of 60 Hadley Road for a remodel of the Car Wash at an estimated market value of \$42,600.00.

The Maintenance Report for June was reviewed next. Patched roads scheduled for summer maintenance; Cut Bentley Avenue to remove cross pipe for replacement to private drainage ditch heading north behind homes on northside of road; Cut driveway on Hamburg Road for driveway pipe replacement; Cleaned ditch along Quarry Hill Road and replaced driveway pipe; Repaired guard rails along Hamburg Road; Hauled mulch for Road Islands and Playground at Park; Piled fill dirt in back lot at Township Building; Repaired sign post on West Methodist Road; Replaced sign post on Scott Road; Installed new Woodland Place Drive Private Drive sign on Donation Road; Cleaned F550 Dump Truck; Greased John Deere Backhoe; Built Hitch Assembly for 99 International Dump Truck; Filled and graded ruts at Park; Cleaned runner rugs at Township Building; Met PennDot Traffic Engineer at Hadley Road/Williamson Road to troubleshoot timing issue at Traffic Signals; Met with site contractor for new Dollar General Store on Mercer Road; Installed brake controller and wiring for lights on new trailer hitch on 99 International Dump Truck; Inspected Playground Equipment at Park for safety concerns; Removed swings off old Swing Sets at Playground, will be removed in the fall; Washed Township Trucks; Weed eat at Park; Set up Park for rentals; Picked up trash along Township Roads; Washed HTPD vehicles numerous times; Cleaned up downed trees along Hamburg Road after storm damage; Cleaned out ditches from storm damage; Patching roads on 2024 Summer Seal Coating list; Serviced HTPD Unit#2; Installed/repaired Merry-Go-Round in Playground at Park; Mulched around Township Building, Islands on Fox Creek Drive and Hollywood Blvd. and Playground at Park; Mowed at Park; Trimmed around Street Signs/Stop Signs along Township Roads; Mowed berms along Township Roads; Replaced Beacon Light and Hydraulic Hose on Lee Boy Asphalt Roller;

Last, The Fire Department had 13 total calls during June, 3 EMS and 10 for Fire. Mutual Aid was given 1 time and received 1 time.

Chairman Hittle opened the miscellaneous portion of the meeting. There were no comments.

Chairman Hittle said he would make a motion that checks be issued in payment of all utility bills, and that all other bills be checked and upon approval, be paid. Supervisor Geisel made that motion, Supervisor Hittle duly seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved by Chairman Hittle. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Supervisor Hittle made a motion to adjourn. The motion to adjourn was duly seconded by Supervisor Geisel, and unanimously approved by Chairman Hittle. Motion carried.
